Bark James Maury Log Book

Mon Jan 26th

Begins with strong Winds from N.W. and Cloudy at 4 P.M. Bent a New Main Top Sail Middle part fresh Sails with Rain Ship under Close Reef Main Top Sail Scatter part the same

Tues Jan 27th

Begins the same Ship laying the same Middle part more moderate Scatter part the same spoke Bark Robt. Morrison 6 Mon out 20 Bbls

Wed Jan 28th

Begins with strong Winds and Cloudy Ship cruising under short Sail saw nothing Middle part the same Scatter part the same Brake out 310 Gal of Water

Thurs Jan 29th

Begins with Moderate Gale and Squally Ship cruising on opposite Tacks Middle part the same Scatter part the same at day light Brake out to stow down the Oil But it came on to Rain and had to knock off

Fri Jan 30th

Begins the same Ship laying two under Close Reef Main Top Sail Middle and Scatter parts the same

Sat Jan 31st

Begins more Moderate Ship still laying two Middle part the same Scatter part finished stowing down the Oil and Brake out 200 Gal of Water

Sund Feb 1st

Begins with strong Winds from N. and pleasant at 3 P.M. made all Sail and stowed Sails for Dissolution Middle part stowed S & S Scatter part fresh Sails from N.W.

Mon Feb 2nd

Begins with strong Gale from N.W. Ship steering S & S under Close Reef Top Sails and Courses Middle and Scatter parts the same

Lat 46. 53 S

Long 63. 30 E

Tues Feb 3rd

Begins the same Ship steering S & S under Double Reef Main Top Sail and Fore Sail Middle part more Moderate turned the Reefs from the Main Top Sail sent down the Fore Sail and retained it Scatter part strong Winds Ship steering S & S

Lat 47. 30 S

Long 63. 39 E

Wed Feb 4th

Begins the same Ship steering S & S Middle part the same Scatter part fresh Winds Ship under all prudent Sail

Thurs Feb 5th

Begins with light Breeze and pleasant Ship steering S & S Middle part the same at day light saw the Land Bearing S.W. by W. by Compass Dist 15 Miles Scatter part fresh Winds and Cloudy Ship steering S & S at 11 P.M. saw Whales chased away the Boats and chased them no success at noon Blowed a Gale of Wind from N.
