Bark James Hawry Log Book
Wednes March 31st

Begins with good weather ship laying at Wichee Watch employed in getting ship ready for sea Watch on Shore in Liberty received on Board 3 tons of Duties Middle part weather the same at Sun Set the Watch came on Board

Thurs Apr 1st

Begins the same Watch employed the same with one Watch ashore in Liberty at sun set the Watch came on Board

Fry Apr 2nd

Begins the same ship laying the same one Watch ashore in Liberty Middle and Leather parts the same

Sat Apr 3rd

Begins the same all hands employed in fitting ship for sea at 5 O'Clock Bark John Wells came into the Harbor and came to Anchor

Sund Apr 4th

Begins with fine weather ship still at Anchor Middle and Leather parts the same

Mon Apr 5th

Begins the same at day light called all hands and hove up Anchor and sailed for sea with a light Breeze from S W Leather part strong Winds ship steering E by N

Tues Apr 6th

Begins with strong Winds from S W ship steering E by N all hands employed in stowing Anchors and Chains Middle part Specially Double Kaps the Top Sails Latter part more pleasant

Wednes Apr 5th

Begins with strong Winds from S S E and pleasant ship steering E by N Middle part the same with heavy Squalls Latter part much the same

Lat 33.44 S
Long 118.36 W

Thurs Apr 8th

Begins with moderate Sails from S and pleasant ship steering E by N at 10 PM kept off N at 5 O'Clock came to the third and took in the fore top sail Middle part the same at day light made all sail and stered by the Wind Latter part the same spoke ship Europa & Olga Adams

Lat 33.20 S
Long 118.30 W

Fry Apr 9th

Begins the same ship - cruising on opposite tacks under all sail sent down the old fore sail and cut it up and bent a new one Middle part the same Leather part the same

Sat Apr 10th

Begins the same ship working the same Middle part took in sail spoke ship Emma C Jones Leather part employed in setting up rigging saw nothing but ships
