Begins with light Winds from the Northward and pleasant Ship steering S S E under all Sail Middle part rainy Latter part the same

Sund May 30th

Begins the same Ship under short Sail Middle part the same Latter part strong Winds Ship steering S S E under Double Reef

Long 179° 13' E

Monel May 31st

Begins the same at 200 took in fore top Sail and came to the Wind Middle part the same Latter part light Breeze Ship cruising under all Sail

Tues June 1st

Begins the same Middle part took in Sail at day light made Sail Latter part rainy

Wednes June 2nd

Begins the same at 6 P took in Sail Latter part pleasant Watch employed in Ships Duties

Thurs June 3rd

Begins with fresh Winds from S W Ship working to Northward & Westward Middle and Latter parts the same Brake out 447 Gal of Water

Fri June 4th

Begins with fresh Winds from W S W and pleasant Ship steering By the Wind to the Northward Middle part took in Sail at day light made Sail and steered to S W

Sat June 5th

Begins the same Ship working the same Middle part Moderate Gales from S W Latter part fresh Gales

Long 178° 28' E

Sund June 6th

Begins with fresh Gales from S W Ship laying to under Close Reef Main top Sail Middle part more moderate Latter part light Breeze from S W Ship under all Sail working to N

Lat 28° 32' S

Long 178° 42' E

Mon June 7th

Begins the same at 4 P M Balm Middle part the same at 4 P M fresh Winds and Squally Latter part strong Winds with rain Ship steering S under all sail

Tues June 8th

Begins much the same Ship steering S at sun set took in Sail Middle part light Winds at day light made Sail and steered S Latter part the same
