Wedns June 8th

Begins with light Winds from N.W. and pleasant Ship steering S.E. under all Sail Middle part took in Sail Latter part fresh Winds and Cloudy

Thurs June 10th

Begins much the same Ship cruising on the same ground Middle part strong Winds Latter part Moderate Gale Ship under Close Reef Top Sails

Lat 31.26 S

Fry June 11th

Begins with moderate Gale from S.W. and pleasant Ship under short Sail Middle part the same Latter part light Winds and Cloudy Ship cruising under all Sail

Sat June 12th

Begins the same Ship cruising the same Middle part strong Wind took in Sail Latter part the same

Sund June 13th

Begins with fresh Winds from W. and Cloudy Middle part the same Latter part the same Ship under Double Reef Top Sails

Begins with strong Winds from W. and pleasant Ship cruising under Double Reef Top Sails Middle and Latter part the same Brake out 348 Gals of Water

Tues June 15th

Begins with strong Winds S and thick Cloudy weather Ship cruising under short Sail Middle and Latter part the same

Wedns June 16th

Begins the same Ship cruising the same Middle part strong Winds and squally Latter part the same

Thurs June 17th

Begins with strong Winds from S.W. and pleasant Ship working to Eastward under Double Reef Top Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same

Lat 31.32 S

Long 122.40 E

Fry June 18th

Begins with pleasant weather and fresh Winds from S.W. Ship steering by the Wind to S.E. under all Sail Middle and Latter parts the same Brake out Dried Apples Beans & Sugar
