light winds and Rain

Begins the same Ship
steering the same in company with
the Bark Susmold & Albin Middle
part fresh winds Latter part the
same

Long 178. 00 W

Sund Aug 15th

Begins with fresh breezes
and pleasant Ship steering N by N under
all sail Middle part strong winds Latter
part steered N N W and N N W

Monday Aug 16th

Begins the same Ship
steering N N W under all sail Middle
part the same at day light saw the Island
of Kientawa Bearing N by S Dist 30 Miles Latter
part fresh winds

Tues Aug 17th

Begins the same Ship steering
for the Island in company with Bark Susmold
and Albin at 2 O' P M came to Anchor in
13 fath of water

Wed Aug 18th

Begins with good weather Ship
laying at Anchor all hands employed in
washing Ship and other Duties Middle part
weather good Latter part the same

Thurs Aug 19th

Begins the same Ship laying
at Anchor all hands employed in getting
bush on shore for water Middle and Latter
parts much the same

Friday Aug 20th

Begins the same Ship laying the
same all hands employed in getting of water
and Recruits Middle and Latter parts the
same Painted Ship out Side
