Tues Sept 15th

Begins with strong Winds from the Southward Ship steering by the Wind under Top Sails at 6⁰⁰ P.M. yet through steering down and cleared up Decks Middle and Latter parts good weather

Long 173.54 W

Wednes Sept 16th

Begins the same Ship working to the Westward Middle part light Air Latter part the same Watch employed in Breaking out 557 Gals of Water

Thurs Sept 17th

Begins with pleasant weather Ship trying to get to the Eastward at 10⁰⁰ took in the Starboard Boat for repairs Middle part fresh Wind from S to Latter part the same

Fri Sept 18th

Begins with fresh Winds from S to Ship working to Windward under all Sail at 7⁰⁰ P.M. Squally Middle part the same Latter part strong Winds

Sat Sept 19th

Begins with strong Winds from the Eastward and pleasant Middle part the same with heavy Squalls of Wind and rain Latter part more pleasant Ship under Double Reef Top Sails working to S S W

Sund Sept 20th

Begins with strong Winds from S N W and cloudy Ship steering by the Wind to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the same

Mon Sept 21st

Begins with strong Winds and pleasant Ship steering by the Wind to the Southward Watch employed in setting up Rigging Middle part the same Latter part the same

Tues Sept 22nd

Begins the same Ship steering the same Middle part Wind hauled to N N W Ship still by the Wind Latter part the same employed in repairing the Jib

Wednes Sept 23rd

Begins the same Ship steering the same at 11⁰⁰ P.M. Sacked Ship and stood to N W under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same Watch employed in Ships Duties

Thurs Sept 23rd

Begins the same Ship steering the same Middle part Rain Latter part the same

Fri Sept 24th

Begins with strong winds from N and heavy Rain Ship steering by the Wind to Eastward Middle part clear Wind N W Latter part Wind S W Ship steering N by W under all Sail
