Bark James Maury's Log Book.

Sat Sept 25th

Begins with light winds from S W and pleasant ship steering N by E under all sail Middle part the same Latter part light winds and calm broke out 220 fath of water

Sund Sept 26th

Begins the same ship steering the same Middle part Cloud with rain Latter part the same Latter part the same

Mon Sept 27th

Begins with squally weather ship working to Northward under short sail saw a number of Fin Backed Shiddu and Latter part rain squalls

Tues Sept 28th

Begins much the same ship steering N and N W W with a strong wind from S W Middle part ship under all sail Latter part the same Watch employed in ship's Duties

Wednes Sept 29th

Begins with fresh winds from S W and pleasant ship steering N and N E Middle part light winds Latter part steered S by S

Lat 26.12 S
Long 179.19 E

Thurs Sept 30th

Begins the same ship steering by the wind to S E Middle part headed S Latter part the same spoke Bark Napolean

Lat 26.02 S
Long 179.01 E

Fry Oct 1st

Begins with pleasant weather ship steering by the wind to Eastward Middle part the same Latter part strong winds from S E and pleasant ship steering off N W W

Lat 25.39 S
Long 179.08 E

Sat Oct 2nd

Begins the same at one o'clock came to the wind on the Port tack Middle part the same Latter part cruising in the same ground saw nothing

Sund Oct 3rd

Begins with strong winds and pleasant ship cruising under prudent sail Middle and Latter part the same

Mon Oct 4th

Begins with strong winds from S E ship steering N N W Middle part steered by the wind to N and Eastward under short sail Latter part the same broke out 686 fath of water

Tues Oct 5th

Begins the same ship steering S W under all sail Middle part light winds ship under short sail Latter part the same ship under all sail cruising

Wednes Oct 6th

Begins the same ship cruising in the same ground Middle part the same Latter part worked to Northward
