Begins with fresh Wind from S.W. Ship steering to Westward By the Wind Middle part the same Latter part pleasant Spoke the English Bark Dearent Hunter Ship working to N

Fry Oct 29th

Begins the same Ship steering N by E under all Sail Middle part took in Sail and came to the Wind Latter part made all Sail and steered N by E
Lat 35.03 S
Long 157.43 E

Sat Oct 30th

Begins with pleasant weather at 1 P.M. Wire Ship and steered By the Wind to S.W. Middle part the same Latter part the same

Sund Oct 31st

Begins much the same Ship cruising under easy sail Middle part light Air and pleasant Latter part the same saw a great many Fin Backs and plenty of feed

Long 156.30 E

Mon Nov 1st

Begins the same Ship steering S.W. under all Sail Middle part took in Sail Latter part made Sail and steered W.S.W. and W by S Watch employed in repairing the Main Sail

Tues Nov 2nd

Begins with fresh Wind from E.N.E. and much Ship steering By the Wind to N under all pendant Sail Middle part took in Sail at day light made sail and worked to Windward

Wednes Nov 3rd

Begins with strong Wind from E and Cloudy Ship steering By the Wind Middle part the same Latter part the same Watch employed in repairing the Top Gallant Sail
Lat 35.34 S
Long 155.48 E

Thurs Nov 4th

Begins much the same Ship steering on Opposite Tacks Middle and Latter part the same

Fry Nov 5th

Begins with strong Wind from W and squally Ship under short Sail cruising Middle part the same Latter part the same saw a great many Fin Backs

Sat Nov 6th

Begins with fresh Sails from N.W. Ship laying two under Close reef Main Top Sail Middle part heavy squalls parted the Top Sail sheet and took it in

Sund Nov 7th Begins the same Ship laying the same Middle part more moderate Latter part the same
