Begins with strong Winds from S W and thick smoky Weather Ship working to Windward under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same

Begins the same Ship trying to get to the Westward Middle part the same Latter part the same

Sat Nov 20th

Begins with strong Winds and pleasant Ship cruising on the same Ground Middle part the same Latter part rain and calm

Begins the same Middle part pleasant and calm Middle and Latter part the same

Mon Nov 22nd

Begins with light Air from the Eastward Ship steering W under all Sail saw two Ships cruising Middle part the same Latter part the same

Begins with fresh Winds from Eastward Ship steering W the Wind to the Northward Middle part the same Latter part the same

Begins with fresh Winds from N W and pleasant Ship working to Eastward under all Sail Middle part took in Sail Latter part made Sail and stowed off S & E

Fri Nov 26th

Begins the same Ship working the same steering S & E and N W Middle part took in Sail Latter part N made Sail and stowed off S & E Broke out 500 Gal of Water

Lat 34.30 S

Long 160.00 W

Sat Nov 27th

Begins with light Winds and pleasant Ship steering N & E under all Sail Middle part took in Sail Latter part made Sail and stowed N & E
