Sund Nov 28th

Begins with fresh Winds from the Westward and pleasant Ship steering to Middle part North in Sail Latter part steered to saw Blk Fish lined and took one

Moncl Nov 29th

Begins the same Ship steering S by E under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part steered N by E saw nothing

Tues Nov 30th

Begins with strong Winds from N.W. and Rainy Ship working to Eastward Middle part the same Latter part steered N by E

Wednes Dec 1st

Begins with strong Winds from W and pleasant Ship steering to under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same

Lat 31.51 S
Long 166.24 E

Thurs Dec 2nd

Begins with fresh Winds from N.W. Ship steering N by E under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same

Lat 31.03 S
Long 167.41 E

Fry Dec 3rd

Begins with light Breeze from the Eastward and pleasant Ship steering N under all Sail Middle and Latter part the same

Lat 30.16 S
Long 167.51 E

Sat Dec 4th

Begins the same Ship steering the same at day light saw Norfolk Island Bearing N.W. by N Dist 40 Miles Middle part the same Latter part steering for the Island

Lat 29.18 S
Long 167.47 E

Sund Dec 5th

Begins the same at 4 P.M. got up to the Island and layed aback Middle part the same Latter part laying off 3 on Capt. Smith went on shore at sun set came on Board and steered off to S.W.

Moncl Dec 6th

Begins with light airs and Calms Ship working to S.W. Middle part the same Latter part the same

Tues Dec 7th

Begins the same Ship working the same Middle part Calm Latter part light Breeze from the southward Brake out 500 Gals of Water
