Suz Jan 8th

Begins with light N. wind and pleasant weather Ship steering by the Wind to S. in the Port Black Middle part the same Latter part the same

Lat 36° 10' S
Long 160° 00' W

Sat Jan 9th

Begins with much the same weather Ship steering the same under all Sail Brake out Water Middle part strong Wind from N. Latter part the same

Lat 37° 03' S
Long 163° 28' W

Sund Jan 10th

Begins with strong Winds from the North and pleasant Ship steering to the Eastward under top Sails carried away the old G. J. M. Middle and Latter parts the same

Lat 37° 12' S
Long 165° 22' W

Mond Jan 10th

Begins the same Ship steering the same Middle part light breeze from N. Latter part fresh Winds Watch employed in making a new G. J. out of a Lower Stud Sail

Lat 37° 16' S
Long 165° 00' W

Tues Jan 11th

Begins the same Ship steering the same at sun set Cabin Middle part the same Latter part fresh Winds from N. got through with the G. J. and bent it

Begins with light N. wind from N. W. and W. N. W. Ship steering to the Northward under all Sail Middle and Latter parts the same

Thurs Jan 13th

Begins with light N. wind from S. W. and pleasant Ship steering N. Middle part Cabin Latter part the same

Lat 34° 30' S

Fri Jan 14th

Begins with a fresh Breeze from S. E. and cloudy Ship steering to the Northward under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same

Sat Jan 15th

Begins with light Winds from the Eastward and cloudy Ship working towards the three Kings saw Blk Fish and took one at 10 P. M. saw the Land Bearing E Dist 40 Miles

Sund Jan 16th

Begins with fresh Winds from the S. E. and smoky Ship steering by the Wind to the Eastward by the Land Middle and Latter parts the same
