Bark James Murray Log Book

Sat Feb 5th

Begins with strong winds from the eastward and pleasant ship at anchor in Bay of Islands Port Watch ashore in Liberty Harbored Watch employed in getting Water Cask on Shore Middle and latter parts the same at Sun Sat the Port Watch came on Board

Sund Feb 6th

Begins the same ship laying the same Harbored Watch ashore in Liberty Middle and latter parts the same at Sun Sat the Watch came on Board 20 knots

Mon Feb 7th

Begins with strong winds from the eastward Port Watch ashore in Liberty Harbored Watch getting ready to break up Oil through the day the ship Bark George and Hunter arrived at Sun Sat the Port Watch came on Board landed the ship at Har to get repaired and the top sail sheets

Tues Feb 8th

Begins the same winds at 5 PM Began to haul ship along side of the ship Bark George Middle part the same latter part the same at 5 PM got along side and made all fast

Wed Feb 9th

Begins with pleasant weather all hands employed in breaking out and discharging Oil on Board the ship Bark George of New Bedford Chas R Tucker Agent through the day discharged 117 Bbls of Oil

Thurs Feb 10th

Begins the same all hands employed in discharging Oil Middle part the same latter part the same Discharged 130 Bbls of Spum Oil

Fry Feb 11th

Begins with strong winds from the eastward and pleasant ship still laying along side of the Bark George Middle part the same latter part rain at 11 AM Am got through discharging 441 Bbls of Oil and hauled off from the Bark George

Sat Feb 12th

Begins the same ship laying the same all hands employed in filling and getting off Water Middle part the same latter part the same

Sund Feb 13th

Begins with calm and pleasant weather ship still at anchor in Bay of Islands on Watch ashore in Liberty Middle part the same latter part the same at 10 PM the Watch all came off

Mon Feb 14th

Begins with pleasant weather Departures through the day was the Bark Wm Barker and Bk Northern Light all hands on Board getting Water

Tues Feb 15th

Begins the same ship laying the same and employed in getting Water through the day received on Board 4 Bbls of Potatoes and 10 Bbls of Water
