Bark James Maury Log Book

Wednes Feb 16th

Begins with fresh Winds and pleasant Starboard Watch ashore on Liberty Port Watch getting the Ship ready for Sea at Sun set Watch came on Board except three Men Namely Charles Morris Henry Wyman and Charles Clifton

Thurs Feb 17th

Begins with cloudy weather Ship still at Anchor in the Bay of Islands ready for Sea Middle part rain and dry

Fry Feb 18th

Begins with strong Winds from S W and pleasant at day light sent the Boat ashore at 8 O'Clock received to Men that Capt. Smith shipped and the Ship sail sheets that we had repaired ashore at 2 O'Clock Capt. Smith came on Board and took our Anchor and steered out of the Bay Weather part steered N E with a fresh Breeze

Sat Feb 19th

Begins the same Ship steering the same Middle part light Air and good weather Latter part the same. Watch employed in sorting over Potatoes

Lat 34. 30 S

Sund Feb 20th

Begins with light Airs from the S W Ship steering N E under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same

Lat 33. 48 S

Long 126. 32 E

Mon Feb 21st

Begins with light Airs from the Westward Ship steering E under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same Landed the Starboard Boat

Lat 33. 30 S

Tues Feb 22nd

Begins the same Ship steering E by N with pleasant Weather Middle part steered the same

Wednes Feb 23rd

Begins the same Ship steering the same Middle part steered N by E Middle part the same Lat 33. 10 S Long 129. 00 E

Thurs Feb 24th

Begins with strong winds from the Northward and thick Cloudy weather Ship working to windward under all sail Middle part the same

Fry Feb 25th

Begins the same Ship steering by the wind to the Northward and Westward Middle part the same Latter part the same

Sat Feb 26th

Begins with strong Winds from the Northward and Cloudy Ship steering by the wind Middle part the same Latter part steered E by E under all Sail
