Sund - March 20th

Begins with very strong winds from the N and cloudy at day light called all hands and cut in the Whale and started the Works Latter part the same

Mond March 21st

Begins the same Watch employed in Bailing Middle part heavy rain Latter part moderate Sales

Lat 30.22 S

Long 178.49 E

Tues March 22nd

Begins the same Watch employed in Bailing Middle part the same Latter part the same got through Bailing

Wed March 23rd

Begins with strong winds from the Eastward and pleasant ship cruising on the same ground saw Whales chased away the Boat Starboard Boat struck and got stove Waist Boat struck and got me took him along side

Thurs March 24th

Begins with strong winds from the Eastward at day light called all hands and cut in the Whale and started the Works Middle part the same Latter part the same

Begins with moderate Sales from the Eastward ship under short sail Bailing Middle and Latter parts the same

Sat March 26th

Begins the same ship still under short sail Bailing Middle part the same Latter part got through Bailing

Begins the same ship cruising on the same ground under short sail Middle and Latter parts the same

Lat 30.24 S

Long 180.00

Mond March 28th

Begins with good weather ship under short sail at 8 AM saw Whales chased away the Boat Starboard Boat had three Whales Missed Waist Boat and Starboard Boat got one apiece and took them to the ship Broke the Starboard Boatsteer and took another Man from Forward to steer the Boat

Tues March 29th

Begins with strong winds from the Eastward at day light called all hands and cut in the Whales and started the Works
