Fry May 20th

Begins with light Air from the Westward Ship working towards Sunday Island Middle & Latter part the same

13 lbs

Sat May 21st

Begins the same at day light saw the Island Bearing E Dist 20 Miles Ship steering for it at 12 O' sent in two Boats to trail could not land it was so rugged and came on Board and kept off N E

Sund May 22nd

Begins with fresh Winds from S W Ship steering N E under all Sail Middle and Latter parts the same

Mon - May 23rd

Begins the same Ship steering the same under all Sails Middle and Latter part the same

Tue May 24th

Begins with fresh Winds from the Southward and pleasant Ship steering N E Middle part the same Latter part light Winds spoke Bark Louise

Wedn May 25th

Begins with good weather Ship cruising in Opposit Tacks Watch employed in repairing the Main Sail Middle part Calm Latter part the same

Lat 25.10 S
Long 135.20 W

Thurs May 26th

Begins much the same Ship working in the same ground Middle part the same Latter part light Air from the Northward

Lat 25.20 S
Long 135.40 W

Fry May 27th

Begins the same Ship working to S W Middle part the same spoke the English Bark Far Away Latter part wind and weather the same

Sat May 28th

Begins with light Air from the Eastward Ship working to the Westward under all Sail Middle part the same Wind hauled to the Northward

Lat 26.00 S
Long 137.00 W

Sund May 29th

Begins with pleasant weather Ship cruising under all Sail saw nothing but Tin Buckets Middle and Latter parts the same
