Begins the same ship still cruising with fresh winds from the Westward Middle and Leater parts the same Spoke ship James Arnold

Begins the same ship working to the Eastward under Top Sails Middle part the same Leater part the same Spoke Bark Louisa

Long 175.20 W

Thurs June 2nd

Begins with fresh winds from the Southward ship working to Eastward Bze the Wind at 12 O'Clock Leat off W Leater part the same

Fri June 3rd

Begins with fresh winds from N & ship steering W under all Sails Middle and Leater parts steering S W with strong winds

Sat June 4th

Begins with strong winds from N & ship steering W W under all Sails Middle and Leater parts the same saw nothing of the Whal keel

Long 178.00 E

Sund June 5th

Begins the same ship steering to the Southward and Westward under all Sails Middle part light Breeze Leater part the same

Mond June 6th

Begins with light Air from the Northward ship working to the Westward Middle and Leater parts the same

Leat 27.00 S

Long 178.00 E

Tues June 7th

Begins with thick weather and rain ship working to S W and light Air Middle and Leater parts the same

Wedns June 8th

Begins the same with plenty of rain ship laying still Middle and Leater parts the same

Leat 27.14 S

Long 177.30 E

Thurs June 9th

Begins with light Breeze from the N and pleasant ship steering to the Eastward Middle and Leater parts the same
