Fry June 10th

Begins with fresh winds from the N^W Ship working to the Eastward under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same
Lat 26° 40' S
Long 178° 30' E

Sat June 11th

Begins the same Ship steering by the wind to the Eastward under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same with rain

Sund June 12th

Begins the same Ship steering the same Middle part strong winds and cloudy Ship steering to the Eastward Latter part the same
Lat 26° 30' S
Long 178° 50' E

Mon June 13th

Begins with cloudy weather Ship working to the Eastward under all Sail Middle and Latter parts the same
Lat 26° 10' S
Long 177° 30' E

Tues June 14th

Begins with fresh winds from N^W and cloudy Ship steering by the wind to Eastward Water employed in setting up shooks for Water Middle and Latter parts the same
Lat on Obs
Long No Obs

Wednes June 15th

Begins with fresh winds from N^W Ship heading to N^W under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part the same
Lat 25° 55' S
Long 175° 00' E

Thurs June 16th

Begins the same Ship steering the same at 5 P^M wind hauled to N^W Ship steering N by W under all Sail Middle part the same Latter part rain

Fry June 17th

Begins with strong winds from S Ship steering N by W under all Sail Middle part moderate Gales and rain Latter part the same
Lat 22° 32' S
Long 174° 24' E

Sat June 18th

Begins the same Ship steering N^W by W under all present Sail Middle part took in Sail Latter part pleasant at day light saw the Island of Eoa Bearing N^N W Dist 30 Miles Ship steering for it under all Sail

Sund June 19th

Begins the same Ship steering along the Land to Westward in company with Bark Louisa Middle part gradually Ship steering N^W clear of the Land and Bent a New Main Top Sail
