Sund Aug 14th

Begins with good weather Boats all off up the Bay saw a few Whales and very shy at 10^{PM} the two Searboard Boats came home and reported very few Whales up to the North End so ends

Mon Aug 15th

Begins the same all the Boats off cruising Louisa's Ben Boat struck and got a Whale and took him along side the James Maury and cut him in

Tues Aug 16th

Begins with good weather Boats all off Shipkeepers cutting the W. at sun set came on Board and started the Whales

Wed Aug 17th

Begins the same Ship still at anchor Boats off cruising struck a Whale to the Searboard Boat and Drawel at sun set came on Board got a Whale to the Louisa

Thurs Aug 18th

Begins the same Boats all off up the Bay saw a few Whales got one to the Louisa

Fry Aug 19th

Begins the same Boats all off out side the Bay saw very few Whales got one to the James Maury
