Mon Aug 29th Begins with strong S & winds and heavy squalls Boats all stopped on Board

Tues Aug 30th Begins the same with rain Boats all on Board waiting for good weather

Wed Aug 31st Begins the same Boats all on Board Wind Blowed strong from S &

Thurs Sept 1st Begins the same Boats still on Board too rugged to lower

Fry Sept 2nd Begins the same no Boats off cruising

Sat Sept 3rd Begins the same Boats all on Board no Whales in the Bay

Sund Sept 4th Begins with moderate Gale from S & S.W. still a Mosher with all the Boats on Board

Mon Sept 5th Begins the same Boats all on Board employed in setting up rigging fore and aft

Tues Sept 6th Begins the same no Boats off and of very few Whales in the Bay

Wed Sept 7th Begins more moderate but not smooth enough to lower the Boats

Thurs Sept 8th Begins the same Boats still on Board

Fry Sept 9th Begins with better weather cleared away The Boats Starboard Boat struck and took a Whale to the Louisa and the Louisa's Bow Boat struck and got another small Whale

Sat Sept 10th Begins the same Boats all off saw very few Whales and shy

Sund Sept 11th Begins the same saw two or three Whales
