Bark James Maury's Log Book

Mond Oct 17th

Begins with fresh winds from the N and Cloudy Ship trying to get to the Northward under all Sail Middle and Scatter parts the same

Tues Oct 18th

Begins the same Ship working the same Middle part Wind hauled to Westward and Light Ship steering N by W for Norfolk Island Scatter part the same

Wednes Oct 19th

Begins the same Ship steering the same Middle part the same Scatter part fresh winds from S by E at day light saw Norfolk Island Bearing N by N Dist 20 Miles at sun set was up to the Island and layed off and on through the Night

Thurs Oct 20

Begins the same with a heavy swell from the S & S by S in Shore Ship laying off and on to get Water but two rugged Middle and Scatter parts the same

Fri Oct 21st

Begins the same Ship still laying off and on but two rugged to get Water weather pleasant and fresh Wind from the Eastward Middle and Scatter parts the same

Sat Oct 22nd

Begins with good weather and fresh Winds from the Eastward Ship still off and on got off 86 Bbls of Water and stored it down middle and Scatter parts the same

Sund Oct 23rd

Begins the same Ship still off and on Starboard Watch went ashore on Liberty at sun set came off

Mond Oct 24th

Begins with strong Winds from S Ship still off and on through the day got off 86 Bbls of Water and stored it down

Tues Oct 25th

Begins the same Ship still laying off & on at Norfolk Island it rugged to land Middle and Scatter parts the same

Wednes Oct 26th

Begins with strong Winds from the southward Ship laying off and under Double Reef Top Sails Middle and Scatter parts the same

Thurs Oct 27th

Begins the same Ship laying off and on the same to rugged to land a Boat Middle and Scatter parts the same
