Bark James Maury's Log Book

Fry Oct 28th

Begins more moderate but still too rugged to land a Boat Ship went round to the North side of the Island

Sat Oct 29th

Begins more moderate at day light sent a Boat ashore Capt Smith and the second Mate come on Board and the First Mate and Third Mate went ashore on liberty

Sund Oct 30th

Begins with good weather Ship still off and on Middle and Scatter parts the same

Mon Oct 31st

Begins the same at day light Capt Smith came on shore and the Third and First Mates went on Board and took on Board 23 Bags of sweet Potatoes and sent on shore 12 Bags of Beans Middle and Scatter parts the same

Tues Nov 1st

Begins the same at day light got off 60 Bbls of Water and sent 2 Boats to the town at sun set the Boats came off with 13 Bags of sweet Potatoes Middle and Scatter parts the same

Wedns Nov 2nd

Begins with calm weather at day light sent the Boat ashore at 11^{oc} the Boat came off and Capt Smith in her and steered for sea with very light Air Middle and Scatter parts the same

Thurs Nov 3rd

Begins the same Island still in night Watch employed in repairing the Fore Sail Middle and Scatter parts the same

Fry Nov 4th

Begins with light Air Ship working to S & Middle and Scatter parts the same

Sat Nov 5th

Begins the same Ship working to S & on Opposite Tacks Middle part fresh Wind from the Eastward Middle and Scatter parts the same took in the Bow and Waist Boats for repairs and put out two New Boats

Sund Nov 6th

Begins the same Ship working to Eastward under all Sail Middle and Scatter parts the same

Begins the same Ship working to windward under all Sail Middle and Scatter parts the same watch employed in Ship's duties
