Begins with good weather and fresh winds from the N. Ship steering to the Eastward under all Sail Middle part the same Scatter part the same

Load 33.00 S

Wednes Nov 9th

Begins with light airs and Calms with good weather Middle part the same Scatter part the same watch employed in repairing the rigging

Thurs Nov 10th

Begins the same at day light saw the three Sloop Bearing S Dist 20 Miles Middle part light Breeze from N Ship steering to weather smoky

Fry Nov 11th

Begins the same Ship steering to the Eastward with light Airs from N N E and Cloudy Middle and Scatter parts the same Watch employed in repairing boats and rigging

Long 124.00 E

Sat Nov 12th

Begins much the same Ship trying to get to the Eastward weather Cloudy and Squally Middle and Scatter parts the same

Sund Nov 13th

Begins with light Airs from the Eastward Ship on Opposite tackes Middle and Scatter parts the same

Begins with fresh winds from the Eastward Ship working to windward took one the Old Boats off the House for repairs Middle and Scatter parts the same

Begins the same Ship working the same Watch employed in overhauling Blocks &c Middle and Scatter parts the same

Wednes Nov 16th

Begins the same Ship on Opposite tackes weather squally Middle and Scatter rain and thick fog

Thurs Nov 17th

Begins with moderate Breezes from S W and S Ship under Close Reef Sep Sails Bze the Wind Middle and Scatter parts the same

Load 36.37 S

Long 126.16 W

Fry Nov 18th

Begins more moderate and pleasant Ship Bze the Wind under all prudent Sail Pointed Starboard Waist and Bow Boats Middle and Scatter parts the same

Sat Nov 19th

Begins with fresh winds from the Southward Ship Bze the Wind under all Sail Middle and Scatter parts the same
