Bark James Naught Log Book

Tues Jan 20th

Begins with fresh winds from the S.W. and pleasant ship working towards the Island saw three ships working the same Middle and Leather parts the same

Lat 44° 30' S

Long 175° 30' W

Sat Jan 21st

Begins the same ship working the same Middle part of the Bark Albin and Cleve Leather part fresh winds from S.W. saw and took a Blk Fish saw Pitt's Island Bearing W Dist 10 Miles

Sund Jan 22nd

Begins with fresh winds from the Southward ship trying to get to South of the Island could not do it Middle and Leather parts the same

Mon Jan 23rd

Begins the same ship still trying to get to the South of Island could not gain any under all sail Middle and Leather part the same

Tues Jan 24th

Begins with the same wind ship off and on the Land Middle part the same Leather part started off to N.E. saw nothing

Wednes Jan 25th

Begins with light winds and pleasant ship working to N.E. Middle and Leather part calm

Lat 44° 20' S

Long 175° 10' W

Thurs Jan 26th

Begins with calm weather ship laying still saw one ship lower her boats and chase a whale 15 Miles to the Westward of us we could not get there Middle and Leather part the same

Fri Jan 27th

Begins with light air and pleasant ship cruising on the same place see nothing but ship Middle and Leather parts the same

Lat 44° 45' S

Long 175° 00' W

Sat Jan 28th

Begins with light breeze and pleasant ship steering to the Westward saw the Land Bearing W Dist 20 Miles Middle and Leather part the same ship working back to Eastward again

Sund Jan 29th

Begins with pleasant weather ship steering by the wind to the Eastward saw nothing Middle and Leather part the same

Lat 44° 28' S

Long 175° 12' W
