Bark James Maury Log Book

Sund Feb 28th

Begins with Moderate Scales from N & and rain Ship laying two under close Reef Main Top Sail at 4 P.M. wind hauling to the North

Wedns March 1st

Begins the same Ship laying two on the Port Jack under close Reef Main Top Sail Middle part the same Latter part more moderate Wind hauling to S & W. Ship and set Double Reef Top Sails Round to the two last Ships in Between Decks behind some bark Both of them alive

Long 176. 00 W

Thurs March 2nd

Begins with pleasant weather Ship working to the North under all present sail Middle part the same Latter part the same at noon the Peramie bore W Dist 15 Miles spoke Bark Abbin

Fri March 3rd

Begins with pleasant weather Ship working to the N & under all sail Watch employed in Ship's Duties Repaired the Main Top Mast Stay sail & Middle and Latter part the same

Lat 44. 35 S

Sat March 4th

Begins the same Ship cruising under all present sail saw nothing Middle and Latter parts the same

Lat 43. 30

Long 175. 00

John & Smith Master

Sund March 5th

Begins with strong winds from the N & and cloudy Ship cruising on the same ground nothing in sight Middle and Latter parts the same

Lat 44. 00 S

Long 175. 10 W

Mond March 6th

Begins with moderate Scales from N & Ship under close reef Top Sails lay the Wind on opposite Sides Middle part the same Latter part wind hauling to Westward

Tues March 7th

Begins much the same Ship by the Wind at 7 P.M. blowed heavy in squalls took in Fore Top Sail Middle part fresh Scales Latter part Ship laying two under close reef Main Top Sail

Wedns March 8th

Begins the same Ship still laying two Wind S & W and heavy Sea running Middle part the same Latter part more moderate

Thurs March 9th

Begins with strong winds from the Westward Ship steering S & under short sail saw a sperm whale and chased away the Boats and never saw the Whale after the Boats landed Boats came on Board
