Begins with fresh winds from the Southward ship cruising on opposite tacks nothing in sight Middle part the same Latter part the same saw Cape Henry Bearing SW Dist 20 Miles spoke Bark Whinn

Sat Apr 22nd

Begins the same ship working to Southward under all prudent sail Middle part the same Latter part the same

Sund Apr 23rd

Begins with good weather ship working to S to under all sail Middle part Cloudy Latter part the same

Mond Apr 24th

Begins with good weather and light airs from the Southward ship working Southward Bark Whinn in sight and plenty of Fin Ducks

Tues Apr 25th

Begins the same ship on the Western Tack under all sail nothing in sight Middle and Latter parts the same Copper employed in repairing rotten bark

Begins with good weather and fresh breeze from S W Ship cruising under all sail Middle and Latter parts wind and weather the same nothing in sight

Thurs Apr 27th

Begins the same ship cruising the same and on the same old ground saw nothing Middle part the same Latter part the same

Fry Apr 28th

Begins with good weather ship cruising on opposite tacks with all sail with watch employed in repairing the old fore top Mast Star Sail Middle and Latter parts the same

Sat Apr 29th

Begins with fresh winds from the Northward ship cruising under all sail Middle part calm Latter part the same

Lat 44. 00 N
Long 175. 00 W

Sund Apr 30th

Begins the same ship laying still Middle light breeze from NW ship beating WSW Latter part the same at 10 O Wind hauled to W tacked ship and made all sail and steered NW
