Sund June 18th

Begins with good weather
at day light called all hands and heaved in
to the whale at 11¹/₂ AM had the whale
all in and kept off N by W with a light breeze
from the SE

Mond June 19th

Begins the same ship steering
the same under all sail Watch employed
in Boiling Middell and Leather parts the
same

Lat 23° 00' S

Long 175° 20' W

Tues June 20th

Begins with fresh trade ship
steering N for the Island of Boa Middell
part the same Leather part the same

Wednes June 21st

Begins the same ship steering
the same get through Boiling saw the Island
of Boa Bearing N Dist 48 Miles Middell
and leather parts the same ship cruising
in sight of the land

Thurs June 22nd

Begins with light breeze
from S ship steering S under all sail
Middell and Leather parts the same
stowed down the oil

Lat 22° 30' S

Long 175° 20' W

Fri June 23rd

Begins with good weather
Ship ship steering S by E under all
sail Middell and leather parts the
same

Lat 23° 30' S

Long 174° 58' W

Begins with strong winds from
N and Rain Ship working to southward
Middell and Leather parts the same

Sund June 25th

Begins with rain and fresh
winds from NW Ship under short sail
Middell and Leather parts the same

Lat 25° 20' S

Begins with fresh winds
from the Westward ship cruising under
easy sail saw nothing Middell and leather
parts the same

Lat 26° 00' S

Long 175° 10' W

Tues June 27th

Begins with good weather
Ship cruising in the same ground nothing
in sight watch employed in ships Duties
Middell and Leather parts the same

Lat 26° 38' S

Long 175° 27' W

Wednes June 28th

Begins with the same
weather ship cruising under all prudent
sail Middell and Leather parts the
same

Thurs June 29th

Begins with light N.W. wind
from S Ship steering N under all sail
Middell and Leather parts the same

Lat 24° 00' S

Long 175° 10' W
