Wed June 30th

Begins with good weather
Ship cruising on the same ground
nothing in sight Middle and Latter
parts the same

Sat July 1st

Begins the same ship cruising
the same watch employed in Ship
Duties of Middle and Latter parts
the same

Lat 24. 20 J
Long 175. 20 W

Sund July 2nd

Begins with Moderate
S.W. from S.W. Ship under short sail
Middle and Latter part the same

Mon July 3rd

Begins the same Ship
cruising under short sail Middle
part more moderate Latter part
the same

Lat 24. 00 J
Long 174. 54 W

Tues July 4th

Begins with good weather
Ship still cruising with nothing in
sight Middle and Latter parts the
same

Wed July 5th

Begins with light Breeze
from S Ship steering N under all
sail saw a ship steering N.E. Middle
and Latter parts ship steering the
same

Lat 23. 00 J
Long 175. 00 W

Thurs July 6th

Begins with light S.W. wind
Ship steering N for the Island of
Jonga Middle and Latter parts the same

Lat 22. 00 J
Long 175. 05 W

Fri July 7th

Begins with good weather and
light winds from S.W. Ship steering N
Middle part the same Latter part saw
the Island of Boca bearing N by W Dist 30 M

Sat July 8th

Begins the same ship steering
N.N.W. at sun set was up to the Island
laid off and in all night at day light
kept off for Jonga Latter part the same
at 4 P.M. got a Pilot on Board and laid
off and in all night

Sund July 9th

Begins with light Air from
N Ship laying off and on at day light kept
off for the Harbor Wind hauled to N.W.
and could not get in laid off and on
Little Boca

Mon July 10th

Begins with light Air
from the Westward Ship still laying off
on on could not get in to the Harbor

Tues July 11th

Begins the same Ship still
laying off on on waiting for the Wind to
haul Middle and Latter parts the same
Latter Boca bore N.W. Dist 5 Mils at 11 P.M.
came to Anchor in Jonga
