Bark James Murray Log Book

Weds Nov 1st

Begins with good weather all hands on Board cleaning and painting Ship Middle and latter parts the same

Thurs Nov 2nd

Begins the same Ship laying the same all hands on Board painting Ship at Sun set got through painting

Fry Nov 3rd

Begins the same all hands on Board taking down the rigging Capt. Smith started for Auckland in the steamer

Sat Nov 4th

Begins the same Ship still at Anchor getting ready for sea got through taking down and washed off decks

Sund Nov 5th

Begins the same Ship laying the same Post Watch ashore in Liberty at Sun set all came on Board

Mon Nov 6th

Begins the same Ship laying the same got off two rafts of water and stored them

Tues Nov 7th

Begins the same all hands painting Ship the second coat

Weds Nov 8th

Begins the same employed in painting at Sun set got through

Thurs Nov 9th

Begins with good weather all hands on Board getting Ship ready for sea got off Wood and Water

Fry Nov 10th

Begins the same Ship laying the same got off the last of the water

Sat Nov 11th

Begins the same all hands on Board at 10 P.M. Capt. Smith arrived from Auckland the Steamer came along side and delivered 15 Bbls of Beef 3000 Lbs of Flour and 3000 Lbs of Bread Cordage and other sundries

Sund Nov 12th

Begins with strong winds from the S Ship still at anchor all hands on Board

Mon Nov 13th

Begins with good weather Starboard watch ashore in Liberty at sun set came on board

Tues Nov 14th

Begins the same Post Watch ashore in Liberty at sun set came on Board Ship ready for sea

Weds Nov 15th

Begins with calm weather could not get underway

Thurs Nov 16th

Begins the same could not get out
