Sat March 23rd

Begins with light this fore N ship steering by the wind to the eastward Middle part fresh winds and hauling to WNW Latter part ship under Double Reef Top Earl's ship making 150 strokes per hour

Sund March 24th

Begins the same at 6 AM take in fore Top Sail Middle part Wind hauling to W at day light kept off to by N and set fore Top Sail Latter part steered to N by

Mon March 25th

Begins more moderate ship steering N by E Middle and Latter part the same Wind hauled to N N W

Lat 36. 15 S
Long 28. 55 W

Tues March 26th

Begins with strong winds from N ship steering by the wind to East Middle part Moderate Sails ship laying two at day light Wind hauled to NW made ship and steered N N by ship making 150 strokes per hour

Wed March 27th

Begins the same Wind hauling to W ship steering N by E Middle part the same Latter part the same

Thurs March 28th

Begins the same ship steering the same Middle part Wind S W Latter part the same with rain

Begins with fresh winds from S W ship steering N by E under all sail Middle and Latter parts the same

Sat March 30th

Begins the same ship steering the same under all sail Watch employed in ship's duties Middle part the same Latter part Wind S and light

Lat 28. 00 S
Long 27. 43 W

Sund March 31st

Begins the same ship steering the same Middle part light this ship steering N by E Latter part the same

Mon March April 1st

Begins with light this ship working to the Northward Watch employed in ship's duties Middle and Latter parts the same

Tues Apr 2nd

Begins with fresh winds from S ship steering N by E under all sail weather clear sun several ships bound to the Southward Middle and Latter parts the same

Wed April 3rd

Begins with good weather ship steering N by E under all sail Watch employed in ship's duties Middle and Latter parts the same
