Wednes Apr 17th

Begins with light Air from the Northward and Calms Ship trying to get to Northward Middle and Latter parts the same

Thurs Apr 18th

Begins the same Ship trying to get to Northward and three Ships Bowmen S. W. Middle and Latter parts the same run a school of ^{and 30} Whales chased away the Boat Harbored Boat Stevedores

Fri Apr 19th

Begins with Delusions Ship with no Storage way on part of the time Middle and Latter parts the same watch employed in Boiling

Sat Apr 20th

Begins with light Air from N. N. E. and rain Middle and Latter parts the same got through Boiling and Cleared up Decks

Sund Apr 21st

Begins with light Air from N. and Squally with Rain Ship standing to N. W. Middle and Latter parts the same

Mond Apr 22nd

Begins the same Ship working on Opposite tack under all Sail Middle and Latter parts the same

Tues Apr 23rd

Begins with baffling sun's Ship working to Northward Middle part fresh Winds from S. E. Ship steering N. E. & Latter parts the same

Wednes Apr 24th

Begins with fresh S. E. Winds Ship steering N. E. & under all Sail Middle and Latter parts the same Lat 1. 37 S Long 34. 58 W

Thurs Apr 25th

Begins with light Air and Rain from N. N. E. Ship steering by the Wind Middle and Latter parts the same

Fri Apr 26th

Begins with calm weather Ship going round and round Middle and Latter part the same

Sat Apr 27th

Begins the same Ship still with no Storage way with plenty of Rain Middle part and Latter part the same

Sund Apr 28th

Begins with light Air from N. E. Ship steering N. N. W. Middle part Rain Squalls and more Breeze Latter part the same

Mond Apr 29th

Begins with light Breeze from N. E. Ship steering N. N. W. under all Sail Middle part Squally Latter part Wind S. E. & Steered N. by W

Tues Apr 30th

Begins with light Winds and Rain Ship steering N. by W under all Sail two more Men came down with the Skerry Middle and Latter parts the same
