Bark James Maury Log Book

Sund May 12th

Begins with good weather
Ship at anchor in Barbadoes Port Water
all hands ashore on Liberty at Sun Sat all came
on board ship ready for sea

Mon May 13th

Begins the same ship
laying the same Port Water ashore on
Liberty at Sun Sat all came off

Tues May 14th

Begins the same at day light
called all hands and hove up anchor and
steered out of the Bay at 12 O'Clock got
clear of the Land and steered N by E
under all sail Capt. Smith took one man
named J. Grennell as Passenger for New Bedford

Wed May 15th

Begins with strong winds from
W & S and pleasant ship steering N under
all sail Middle and Latter parts the
same

Thurs May 16th

Begins the same ship steering
N with all sail Water employed in Ship's
Duties Middle and Latter parts the
same

Lat 18° 00' N

Long 60° 30' W

Fri May 17th

Begins the same ship steering
the same Middle part the same
Latter part slightly and wind hauling
to Southward

Lat 20° 00' N

Long 61° 00' W

Sat May 18th

Begins with light and buffing
winds ship steering to the N by E under
all sail Middle and Latter parts the same

Sund May 19th

Begins much the same ship
working the same Middle part Saloon
Latter part light this from the Westward

Lat 21° 20' N

Long 61° 40' W

Mon May 20th

Begins with light winds
and Saloon ship working to N by W under
all sail Middle and Latter parts the
same

Lat 22° 45' N

Long 62° 30' W

Tues May 21st

Begins much the same ship
trying to get to the Northward Middle
and Latter parts the same

Lat 23° 35' N

Long 63° 00' W

Wed May 22nd

Begins with light winds and
Saloon ship working to Northward under
all sail Middle part the same Latter
part Gulls of Barn

Thurs May 23rd

Begins the same ship
working the same saw a number of
ships bound to N W Middle and Latter
parts weather the same
