Bark James Maury Log Book

June Mond 3rd

Begins with light breeze from N^W and pleasant ship steering N^W under all sail Middle part calm latter part light breeze from N^W ship steering by the wind to E^N at day light throwed the Jy hooks over board and hauled up the chains

Lat 32° 42' N
Long 71° 50' W

Tues June 4th

Begins the same at 10 P^M calm at 3 P^M get a light breeze from N^W ship steering N under all sail Middle part wind hauled to S latter part fresh winds at 2 P^M saw Montauk Point Bearing N^W Dist 20 Miles ship steering for Block Island

Wednes June 5th

Begins with strong winds from S ship steering N^W and N^E at 2 P^M took a Pilot Block Island Bearing N^W Dist 10 Miles steered E^N for Southunk Island at 3 P^M get into the Bay at 8 P^M came to anchor off Clark Point weather rising and blowing strong from S^E at 8 P^M made all snug and so ends the voyage of the Bark James Maury
