

Remarks On Board Ship James of New Bedford, Mass.

Satter part light trades at 6 Am began to cut in the whale at 9.15 Am finished cutting, saw the Bark Sea Breeze & one merchantman.

Remarks Monday May 18th.

Sight trades heading to the S.W. sailed the case and cut up the junk, employed boiling the head. at sunset double reefed the topsail, were round and headed to the E. N.E.

Middle part light trades heading Eastward boiling. Satter part light trades heading Eastward, employed boiling the body.

Satt 16.45 S. Long 4.45 W.

Remarks Tuesday May 19th.

Sight trades heading Eastward, boiling, saw a merchantman at sunset tacked and headed to the S.W.

Middle part light trades heading S.W. at 10 Pm finished boiling. Satter part light trades heading to the S.W. saw several Gimbachi.

Satt 17.15 S. Long 4.54 W.

Remarks Wednesday May 20th.

Sight trades heading to the E. S.E. saw a white water, found the tank leaking, lashed the hoops and stopped it. Gauled the light sails.

Middle part light trades heading Eastward, at midnight tacked to the S.W. Satter part fresh trades steering N.W.W. employed stowing down the oil, saw porpoises, saw one sail heading Eastward, at noon saw the Island St Helena.

Remarks Thursday May 21st.

Fresh trades steering N.W.W. finished stowing the oil stowed down by the gauges of the cask 123.22^{gal} of Sperm Oil, and have an sledge left of about 2^{gal}, spoke the Bark Sea Breeze in charge of Mr. Luffy. The Captain ashore sick, at sunset hauled to the wind and headed to the Eastward, saw a Gimbachi.

Middle part fresh trades heading Eastward, at 1 Am tacked to the S.W. Satter part fresh trades steering Northward towards the Island employed breaking out for pipe shocks, saw two sails.

Remarks Friday May 22nd.

Fresh trades steering different courses saw two sails, saw a white water, at sunset heading South.

Middle part fresh trades heading South at 2 Am tacked to the E.E.

Captain Joseph H. Cornell, A.D. 1863.

Satter part fresh trades steering to the North employed cooping the bread and sails in pipes from between decks aft, opened a cask of Flour, started one Bl of Beef and one Bl of Tack.

Remarks Saturday May 23^d.

Fresh trades steering different courses, at 3 Pm. The Ship close to the Island, off the West side, saw several sails, at sunset heading S.W.

Middle part fresh trades heading S.W. Satter part strong trades heading E.E. The Island St Helena in sight.

Remarks Sunday May 24th.

Strong trades heading E.E. at 3 Am tacked to the Southward.

Middle part fresh trades heading Southward. Satter part fresh trades heading South.

Satt 18.19 S.

Remarks Monday May 25th.

Fresh trades heading South, at sunset tacked to the S.E. Gauled the light sails.

Middle part light trades heading to the N.E. Satter part light trades heading E.E. saw a number of Gimbachi.

Satt 18.57 Long 5.38 W.

Remarks Tuesday May 26th.

Sight trades heading E.E. saw Gimbachi, at sunset Gauled the light sails.

Middle part light trades heading E.E. Satter part light trades with strong glow, steering different courses North to E.N.E. saw Gimbachi, one whale The Sea Breeze in sight.

Remarks Wednesday May 27th.

Fresh trades steering different courses from N.W. to E.E. at sunset tacked to the S.W. saw the Island St Helena and two sails. Gauled the mainsail and double reefed the topsails.

Middle part fresh trades heading to the S.W. Satter part fresh trades with squalls, at daylight were round and headed Eastward, saw Gimbachi, at 11 Am saw a school of sperm whales about one mile off the lee beam going to the S.W. quite quick, lowered for them but did not succeed in striking on account of the rudder to the Base Boat
