Remarks Monday February 15th.

Light trades steering S. S. E. saw porpoises, Gumboots, & grampuses.

Middle part light trades steering N. N. E.

Latter part light trades steering N. N. E. the coast of Peru in sight, smoky days saw Blackfish lowered and caught one in the morning, saw Gumboots, porpoises, several schools of Blackfish a few sails coastward, at noon saw a Steamer in shore steering Northward.

Satt 6.02 S. Long 81.28 W.

Remarks Tuesday February 16th.

Light trades steering Northward, saw several schools of Blackfish.

Middle part light trades steering Northward.

Latter part light trades in the morning the ship steering for Paita head, about 8 Am the Captain went on shore at Paita, the ship standing off on. there are two mail Steamers here one bound North, the other South, Hooker.

Remarks Wednesday February 17th.

Fresh trades at 1.30 Pm the Captain came on board and took his departure, received on board a few sweet potatoes.

Middle part light trades steering S. S. W.

Latter part light trade steering S. S. W. employed boiling the Blackfish. it made one barrel of Oil, saw grampuses, Blackfish &c.

Satt 3.03 S. Long 81.42 W.

Remarks Thursday February 18th.

Light trade nearly calm, steering S. S. W. saw Blackfish. saw a swordfish, lowered for him, and my boatstewer missed him, darted over him a good chance square off and on, the fish on top of water.

Middle part light trade steering N. N. W.

Latter part equally in the morning had some rain, at 8 Am light breeze from the S. N. E. backing to the S. E. steering North, em-

played washing the ship outside, sand in sight.

Satt 2.12 S. Long 81.32 W.

Remarks Friday February 19th.

Light breeze from the S. S. E. steering N. N. E. sand in sight, Antonio Gomez, boatstewer, has gone me some insolence, for which I slipped him, over the head to day, he has been rather insolent for some time.

Middle part light air from the South, steering Northward.

Latter part light air from the South, steering Northward, employed painting the ship, outside, sand in sight, saw a humpback and Blackfish.

Remarks Saturday February 20th.

Light breeze from the Westward steering S. S. W. at 2 Pm had a squall with a light breeze, but no rain, broke out better, Proves, started 2.00 of fish & 1.00 of beef, at dusk, the wind veered to North, had some rain.

Latter part light breeze from the North, steering N. S. W. caught a turtle.

Light breeze from the North, steering N. S. W.

Middle part light breeze from the N. N. E. steering N. S. W.

Latter part light breeze from the N. E. steering N. S. W. saw a Gumboot.

Satt 2.28 S. Long 84.13 W.

Remarks Monday February 22nd.

Light air from the North, steering N. S. W.

Middle part light breeze from the North steering N. S. W.

Latter part light air from the N. N. E. steering N. S. W. took the Starboard boat on deck to clean her out, and fix her.

Satt 2.58 S. Long 85.15 W.

Remarks Tuesday February 23rd.

Light air from the N. N. E. steering N. S. W. painted under the ceiling of the Starboard boat, and put her out on the cranes.

Middle part light air from the N. S. E. steering N. S. W.

Latter part the same took the Starboard boat in for repairs, painted the Starboard boat.

Satt 2.55 S. Long 86.11 W.
