Middle part light air and calm.

Satter part light air from the Northward, heading to the N.W. sent down the main top gallant sail for repairs.

Remarks Wednesday March 9th.

Light air and calm heading from West to N.W. finished the gallant sail.

Middle part light breezy with calm.

Satter part light breeze from Northward by N. heading to the N.E. at 8 Am. tacked and headed N by N.

Satt 3.45 N.

Song 98.08 W.

Remarks Thursday March 10th.

Light breeze from the North heading N by N. at sunset set the royal.

Middle part light breeze from the North heading N by N. & N.W.

Satter part the same, employed rattling the mizzen rigging & making spars, etc.

Satt 4.25 N.

Song 99.11 W.

Remarks Friday March 11th.

Light breeze from the North heading N by N. and N.W. at sunset set the royal.

Middle part light breeze from the North heading N by N.

Satter part the same, employed rattling the fore and main topmast rigging, etc.

Satt 4.46 N.

Song 101.06 W.

Remarks Saturday March 12th.

Light breeze from the North heading N by N. at sunset set the royal, heading N.W.

Middle part light breeze from the N.W. steering N.W.

Satter part the same, wet the oil in the morning. Gustavus Foster gave me violence this morning, I struck him, and he took a hold of me, for which he got a thrashing by the Captain, and sent to masthead.

Satt 5.48 N.

Song 103.09 W.

Remarks Sunday March 13th.

Light N.E. trade, steering N.W. at sunset set the royal.

Middle part light N.E. trade, steering N.W.

Satter part the same, at 4 Am. saw a school of sperm whales off the leeward working to windward, lowered and succeeded in capturing one, at 11 Am. took the whale alongside, and got ready for cutting.

Satt 6.35 N.

Song 104.50 W.

Remarks Monday March 14th.

Light N.E. trade wind, employed cutting the whale, at 2.30 Pm finished cutting, and set all sail, steering N.W. at sunset set the royal.

Middle part light trades, steering N.W. cleared away the head.

Captain Joseph H. Cornell, A.D. 1864.

Satter part light trades, steering N.W. employed boiling the head started two barrels of pork, and one of beef.

Satt 7.50 N.

Song 107.11 W.

Remarks Tuesday March 15th.

Light N.E. trade wind steering N.W. by N. employed boiling, at sunset set the royal.

Middle part fresh trade wind, steering N by N. finished boiling.

Satter part the same, the whale made about 25 barrels, cleared up, washed off the deck, etc.

Satt 8.55 N.

Song 110.02 W.

Remarks Wednesday March 16th.

Fresh trade wind, steering N by N. & N.W. at sunset set the royal.

Middle part fresh trades, steering N.W.

Satter part light trades, steering N by N. employed setting up sheets and setting rigging, saw a finback.

Satt 9.33 N.

Song 112.51 W.

Remarks Thursday March 17th.

Fresh trades steering N by N. at sunset set the royal.

Middle part light trade wind steering N by N.

Satter part fresh trades steering N by N. saw a breck several times, supposed a finback, saw a spout two times two rising, broke out some sheets.

Satt 10.22 N.

Song 115.37 W.

Remarks Friday March 18th.

Light trade wind steering N by N. at sunset set the royal.

Middle part fresh trades, steering N by N.

Satter part fresh trades steering N by N. employed setting up sheets & rattling mizzen topmast rigging.

Satt 11.16 N.

Song 118.50 W.

Remarks Saturday March 19th.

Fresh trades steering N.W. at sunset set the royal.

Middle part fresh trades steering N.W.

Satter part strong trades steering N.W. employed setting up pipe sheets, etc.

Satt 12.04 N.

Song 122.14 W.

Remarks Sunday March 20th.

Strong trades steering N.W. squally with some rain.

Middle part strong trades, steering N.W.

Satter part strong trades, steering N.W. cloudy weather.

Satt 12.45 N.

Song 126.19 W.

Remarks Monday March 21st.

Strong trades steering N.W. at 4 Pm squally with the wind well to the North, steering West.
