Latter part strong wind from the SW steering E by S, at 4 Am steering N. N. E. at noon steering E by S again. Captain Cornell has been sick for the last two weeks, and has now concluded to go back for medical assistance.

Remarks Thursday May 26th.

Strong breeze from the SW steering E by S. At sunset all sail set. Fog.

Middle part fresh breeze from the Southward, steering E by S.

Latter part light breeze from the S. E. baffling heading E. N. E. & N. E. at 6 Am were round and headed South & E by S. bent a new main top gallant sail, started 2nd of Deck and 1st of Mast, filled the Boat, broke out Sugar, cheese, soap, and flour. Thick fog.

Remarks Friday May 27th.

Strong breeze from the S. E. baffling Southward, heading South to S. W. at 3.30 Pm were round and headed Eastward, thick fog weather, at sunset heading E by S, all sail set.

Middle part strong breeze from the South, heading E by S, thick weather.

Latter part A moderate gale from the South, steering East, had fog squalls, thick weather. The sun out at intervals &c. at noon the wind from S. W.

Strong wind from the SW steering E by S, at 4.30 Pm steering East.

Middle part strong wind from the SW steering East, had some light drizzling rain squalls, took in light sail, at midnight set them again.

Latter part strong breeze from the SW baffling, steering East, all sail set.

Latter part strong wind from S. E. heading E by S. Moderating, made sail, at 11 Am nearly calm. the wind baffling Southward, thick weather, with fog. were round and headed to the N. E.

Fresh breeze from the SW steering E. S. E. with all sail set.

Middle part fresh breeze from the SW baffling Southward, steering E. S. E.

Latter part light breeze from S. W. steering E. S. E. sent aloft the main royal yard and sail.

Satt by Act 42. 10 N. Long by Act 164. 16 W.

Remarks Saturday June 4th.

Light breeze from the South baffling, heading E. S. E. to East, repaired the Fore Royal.

Middle part fresh breeze from S. E. heading E by S.

Latter part strong breeze from the S. E. heading E by S. had a few squalls, with light drizzling rain, took in the light sail.

Remarks Sunday June 5th.

Strong wind from the South, baffling to the SW, heading from E. S. E. to S. E. under whole topsails, courses, gill, &c. at 5 Pm steering S. E.

Middle part strong breeze from the SW, steering S. E.

Latter part strong breeze from the SW baffling steering S. E. with all sail set, saw 3rd back, Seal, and plenty whale feed.

Satt 38. 38 N. Long 159. 26 W.

Remarks Monday June 6th.

Strong breeze from the SW baffling, steering S. E. & S. considerable swell on from the Westward.
