

Remarks on Board The Barque Pleiades

Saturday August 22th 1840

Begins strong winds from the North East
Middle part Calms and squally latter much
This same Do Ends

Sunday August 23th 1840

Begins with light winds and variable a tail
In sight Middle part squally latter strong
from S.W. sent out topmast standing sail
Do Ends Lat 37.20 Long 50.40

Monday August 24th 1840

Begins strong winds from N.W. ship
steering S by W latter part much as the
first Lat 37.45 Long 54.32

Tuesday August 25th 1840

Begins light winds from the Westward
Ship steering S by E a sail in sight
steering N by E latter strong winds
Do Ends

Wednesday August 26th

Begins strong winds from the Westward
Ship steering E by S Middle and latter
much the same Do Ends

Thursday August 27

Begins strong winds from N.W. ship
steering S by S Middle part squally
latter strong winds Lat 39.37 Long 42.50

Friday August 28th 1840

Begins strong winds from N.W. ship stea.
S by E Middle squally latter strong winds
Lat 39.24 Long 39.28

Bound To wards The Cape Verde

Thursday Sept 10th 1840

Begins light winds from S.E. ship stea-
ring S.W. at 2 came up a latter part
much the same at 11 AM sighted Black fish
bored the boats without success Do Ends

Friday Sept 11th 1840

Begins light winds and calms latter
light winds from the N.W. ship steering S by E
Do Ends

Saturday Sept 12th 1840

Begins light winds from the N.W. ship steering
S by E Ends much the same

Sunday Sept 13th 1840

Begins light winds from the S.E. ship
steering S.W. a sail in sight Middle
part squally latter strong winds from
the S.E. ship heading S.W.

Monday Sept 14th 1840

Begins strong winds from the S.E. ship
heading S.W. middle and latter part ship
heading S Lat 34.57

Tuesday Sept 15th 1840

Begins strong winds from the E ship
steering S by E latter much the same
Do Ends Lat 22.53

Wednesday Sept 16th 1840

Begins strong S.E. trade ship steering
S by E latter much the same
Do Ends Lat 20.40
