 63 Middle part squally saw porpoises. Latter part the same. Thus End  
 Lat 6:15 N Long 21 05 West

Monday Nov 9th Commenced with Light Winds and squally Wind S.E. courses  
 64 South saw a latter spout saw porpoises thus End this day  
 Lat 5:20 Long 21 40

Tuesday Nov 10th Commenced with Light Windy and squally from S.E. by the Wind on opposite Tacks saw  
 65 25 sails  
 N Lat 4:35 Long 20 58

Wednesday Nov 11th Commenced with Light Windy from South to E at  
 66 4 PM took a very heavy squall with all sail out we reduced her to a short keel Main Top sail and J. J. & Spewary saw 1 Bark by the Breeze steering Southward thus End  
 Lat 3:25 Long 21 30

Thursday Nov 12th 1840 Commenced with Light winds and squally from S.E. standing on the wind to the Southward Middle and  
 67 Latter part the same  
 Lat 2:05 Long 22 05

Friday Nov 13th 1840 Commenced with Light winds and squally from the S.E. standing to the Southward with all sail out  
 68 Lat 1:31 Long 22 14

Saturday 14th Commenced with Light winds and squally from the S.E. Middle and latter part showing breezes from the S.E. thus End  
 69 Lat 1:31 Long 22 58  
 Lat 00 08 miles North Long 24:11

Sunday Nov 15th Commenced with Light breezes from the S.E. heading S.W. with all sail out Middle part squally Latter part the same thus End  
 70 South Lat 1:30 West Long 25 08

Monday Nov 16th 1840 Commenced with strong Easterly trade heading S.S.W. with all sail out all hands employed at working on the rigging thus End  
 71 Lat 3 50 Long 25 02

Tuesday Commenced with strong S.E. trade heading S.S.W. all sail out all hands employed working on the rigging Middle and latter part the same thus End  
 72 S Lat 6:10 Long 27 01

Wednesday Nov 18 Commenced with strong S.E. trade heading S.S.W. employed putting the rigging at  
 73 6 PM called all hands to witness punished Munt Inflicted on the Cook William Bell for disobeying the Capt's order by fighting 14 lashes with his shirt on a thick rod with a small sized setting staff
