

Remarks on board Barque Casper

Thursday Nov 19th 1840

Commenced with strong S & E trade
heading S by W. with all sail out
74 Middle and latter part the same
they ended this day fitting rigging
all hands

Lat 11° 07' Long 27° 50'

Friday Nov 20th commenced with
Light S & E trade heading S by W. all
75 sail out Middle part the same
all hands employed latter part
squally sent down the fore stay
and fitted it they ended this day

Lat 12° 30' Long 28° 03'

Saturday Nov 21st commenced with
strong breeze and squally all
76 hands employed at fitting rigging
saw fire bark they ended this day

Lat 15° 20' Long 28° 04'

Sunday Nov 22nd commenced with strong
breeze and pleasant weather Middle
77 part squally latter part the same
ended Lat 17° 30' Long 28° 08'

Monday Nov 23rd commenced with
strong breeze and squally Middle and
78 latter part the same they ended this day

Lat 19° 50' Long 28° 12'

Tuesday Nov 24th commenced with
strong breeze and squally from
79 E going south all hands employed
at fitting the rigging they sail
in sight sent in the Dolphin
stake and made a new one

Lat 23° 05' Long 28° 14'

for the Indian Ocean Cap. A. A. A.

Wednesday Nov 25th commenced
with light wind and squally at
80 10 P.M. saw a sail Wind E by S
steering south all hands employed
at fitting ship they ended this day

Lat 25° 05' Long 27° 53'

Thursday Nov 26th commenced
with strong breeze and squally
80 weather all hands employed at
various jobs exchanged signals with
a Chilean bark standing N by E
S they ended going south wind E by E
