all sail out saw to the N.W. on the wind
& fir back & presently they end

Friday 11th Commence with strong
gale from the S.E. & squally lower
S.W. by W. saw porpoises & hump back
Latter part end with heavy Gale
steering S.W. by W. with top sail
out

Lat 17:59 Long 99:58

Saturday 12th Commence with heavy
Gale and squally from the S.E. steering
S.W. by W. by W. with all sail out put
Double Lashings on the Boats Latter part
more moderate

Lat 19:30 Long 96:55

Sunday 13th Commence with light
breeze and light lower S.W. by W. all sail
out thus end this 24 hours

breeze and cloudy with sail out
thus end this 24 hours

and from different quarters lower S.W.
all sail out Latter part strong
