strong gales
Lat 24.40 Long 168 20

Friday
7th commences with tremendous gales
from the S E Lying too under Bare
poles With head S E & a tremendous
Sea Middle & Latter part the same
Took in the Waist Boat turned up
the Starboard Boat put on the back
Barr made every thing secure for
a hurricane they end his day
Lat 23.20

9th Commences with strong gales steering N W
Wind S E and south then S W Middle
Sun & Latter part the same they end
steering N by W
Lat 20 03 Long 169.03 West

10th Commences with strong gales from the
S E by S steering N W West Middle part
Lying too under C R M S & A sail they end
Lat 18.53 Long 169 28 East

Tues
11th commences with strong gales still lying
too saw Savage Island steering N by W
to N by E they end
Lat 18 34 Long 169 00

Wed
12th commences with strong gales from the
East Lying too Middle & Latter part
the same sailing they end with squally
Lat 18.10 Long 170 18

Thurs
13th commences with heavy gales and rain
squally from the S E head S E Lying too
under C R M S & A sail & M S pin
Middle & Latter part A perfect Hurricane
Lat 18.03 Long 169.58

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
