6th Commences with Light pleasant
weather from N E head N N W
all sail out Employed at mending
Tack Middle & Latter part the same
Lat 3⁵² 172⁰⁰

Sunday 7th Commences with strong breeze from
the E N E head Northward Employed
at Ship Duty
Lat 2³⁶ Long 172¹⁵

Sandwich Islands Chester Is Smith
8th Commences with strong breeze from
the E N E head Northward all sail out
Employed at Ship Duty Latter part storm
down one side of the Deck while
Lat 00⁴⁶ Long 168⁵⁵

9th Commences with strong breeze from
the E N E steering to the Northward
by the Wind Employed at Ship Duty
Lat 48⁰⁰ North 169¹⁷
Long 168⁵⁹

10th Commences with Light breeze & calm
from the E N E head northward all sail
out Employed at Ship Duty they End
Lat 45 miles N Long 169⁵²

11th Commences with strong current
setting Westward and Light Wind & calm
steering East Wind S E West
Lat 48 miles N Long 169⁵⁸

12th Commences with Light breeze and strong
current. Wind at N. current setting
West at the rate of 1¹/₂ miles per hour
they End Lat 1⁰⁰ North Long 173⁴⁵

13th Commences with Light breeze from
the S E head E N E all sail out
Middle & Latter part the same
saw porpoises
Lat 28 Long 168⁴⁴ West
