13d Commences with light breezes
& calm saw nothing but the
land whyher Dist 7 1/2
Leagues they end

Friday
4th Commences with light air
and calm they end
No obs

Saturday Commences with light air
Middle part Latter part strong breezes
under close reef fore & main
top sail they end

Sunday 5th Commences with strong breezes
head southward they end
Lat 18 07

Monday 7th 1848 Commences with strong breezes
from Eastward head southward
Middle & Latter part the same
Employed mending a boat
they end this day
Lat 17 00 Long 155 40 West

Tuesday 8th 1848 Commences with strong breezes
head southward Employed
mending a boat they end
Lat 16 14 Long 155 20

Wednesday 9th Commences with strong breezes
& squally head South E. Wind
& N E. they end the same
Lat 15 48 Long 154 40

Thursday 10th Commences with strong breezes
& squally from E N E head
S E they end the same
Lat 13 40 Long 154 14

Friday 11th Commences with strong breezes
& squally from the E N E head
S E under double reef top sail
jill & spanker & covering they end
Lat 12 20 Long 153 04

Saturday 12th Commences with light breezes
& squally with rain Employed at
Ship Deck head Eastward & end
from various quarters they end
Lat 11 10 Long 152 00
