Saturday 15th Sept. Oct 1848
Commences with fine pleasant weather &
strong Breezes from the South head on
opposite Tacks Middle & Latter part the
same they Endy Noby

Sunday 16th 1848
Forepart strong Breezy head S E wind south
ward Middle & Latter part the same
they Endy Land in sight Point Jelica
Lat 120 miles North

Monday 16th 1848
Forepart strong Breezy from S W by South
head West by N all sail out Land still
in sight Middle & Latter part the
same they Endy

Lat 108 Long 80.25
Tuesday 17th 1848
Forepart strong Breezy from the South
heading to the Westward all sail out
Middle & Latter part the same they Endy
saw a humpback Lat 121 North Long 83.32

Wednesday 18th 1848
Forepart strong Breezy from the South
head to the Westward all sail out
Middle & Latter part the same
Noby

Thursday 19th 1848
Forepart strong Breezy from
the S S W Middle & Latter part
the same they Endy

Friday 20th 1848
Forepart strong Breezy and fog
they Endy the same

Saturday 21st 1848
Forepart Light present weather from S S W head
West Middle & Latter the same Made the Island
of Cullpeper & Wunnam Dist 20 miles
Bearing W by S they Endy

Lat 128 Long 92.00
Sunday 22d 1848
Forepart Light Breezy & pleasant from South
head W by S they Endy the same
Noby

Monday 23d 1848
Forepart Light Breezy from the South on opposite
Tack spoke ship Empire Upham Nantucket
10 miles 140 st Middle & Latter part heading
Eastward they Endy Empire in sight

Tuesday 24th 1848
Forepart Light Breezy from the South head
Eastward saw the Island of Manxton
Land Bearing S by E Dist 28 miles at East
and North head of Abbeismar Bearing
S E by S Dist 40 miles the Empire still
in sight Middle & Latter part
the same Noby they Day

Wednesday 25th 1848
Commences with light breezy Working
up to Abbeismar they Endy
Lat 20 miles N

Thursday 26th
Commences with light breezy working up
to Abbeismar in company with Empire
they Endy Land Dist 20 miles
