Commences with Light breezes from the South head on opposite tack
Saw 3 ship gunned with Empire & messenger Another 15 more or less
They end 3 ship in sight
Saturday 28th 1848
Commences with strong trade on opposite tack 3 ship in sight
Middle part saw 4 ship, the dist 10 miles
They end this day

Sunday 29th 1848

Commences with Light pleasant weather from the South head in, shore land
Dist 12 miles 22 M at Day
Light saw a shoal of
Sperm Whales lowered at
8 P.M. & S B S B struck
at 9 took him to the ship and commenced cutting at 1 P.M. finished cutting at 3 P.M. saw 3 ship the Korker get 100 more than may we do every day

Monday 30th 1848

Commences with Light pleasant weather commenced boiling at 7 & 11 ship in sight saw 3 ship, 2 boiling they end this day

Tuesday 31st 1848

Commences with fine pleasant weather from the South saw 3 ship 2 boiling spoke ship Wm. West at 3 A.M. finished boiling Land in sight they end

Cruising off Galapagos

Wednesday Nov 1st 1848

Forepart fine pleasant from the South
Nov 5th in sight saw Black fish
they end Land in sight

Thursday Nov 2nd 1848

Commences with fine pleasant weather from South 4 ship, 1 heavy rain in sight Land Dist 8 miles
Middle & Letter part the same

Friday Nov 3rd 1848

Forepart Light breezes Middle & Letter part the same gunned with 3 ship they end

Saturday 4th 1848

Forepart Light breezes from the South Middle & Letter part the same spoke ship Marcus Capt. Osborn fair Haven 14 m 250 sh. Land in sight Dist 10 miles they end

Sunday 5th 1848

Forepart Light breezes from the South on opposite tack Middle & Letter part the same they end this day

Monday 6th 1848

Forepart Light breezes from the South on opposite tack Middle & Letter part the same they end

Tuesday 7th 1848

Forepart Light breezes from the South on opposite tack Middle & Letter part the same
