Middle & Latter part the same thus End

Thursday 9th 1848

Forepart Light Breeze from the South
saw the Hove took 100 lbs Whale
& Ship in sight thus End

Friday 10th 1848

Forepart Light Breeze - Pleasant
Middle & Latter part the same thus
End

Saturday 11th

Forepart Light Breeze and pleasant
Middle & Latter part the same
thus End

Sunday 12th 1848

Fore Strong Breeze from the South
Middle & Latter part the same

Monday 13th

Forepart fine Middle & Latter part
the same thus End the 24 hours

Tuesday 14th

Forepart Light Breeze from the S B
head on opposite tack, Middle & Latter
part the same thus End

Wednesday 15th

Forepart Light Breeze and pleasant
from the South Middle & Latter part
the same thus End

Around the Islands Sept 6th 1848

Nov 1848

Wednesday Thursday 16th

Forepart Light Breeze & pleasant at 12
raised a Shoal ~~SB~~ of Sp. Whely
Lowered all 3 Boats ~~48~~ got one
to the S B at 4 took him
to the Ship & commenced cutting
at Dark got the Body in Sails &
the Body all Night thus End the first
part spoke big Neptune Callio got mott
in & since we say the last thus End

Friday 17th

Forepart commenced Boiling Middle
& Latter part the same saw 2 ships

Saturday 18th

Forepart finish Boiling both
Middle part - Exchanged Signally with
one of G. Howland's ships, saw another
thus End

Sunday 19th 1848

Forepart Strong Breeze from the
S Middle & Latter part the
same thus End
