they endy they dgy

Tuesday 21st 1848
Forepart Employed at showing down
Middle part took in sail for the night
Wind at S E head & saw a large thick
Middle & Letter part Light Breeze finished
showing down

Wednesday 22nd 1848
Forepart Light pleasant weather saw
black fish lower all 3 boats 2 boats struck
and lost then Middle & Letter fine Breeze
saw nothing Land in sight they endy

Thursday 23rd
Forepart Light pleasant weather Middle
& Letter the same spoke ship Rocoe
13 mo 950 sp -- they endy

Friday 24th
Forepart Light breeze and pleasant Middle
& Letter part the same spoke
Ship Rocoe & Marcy 13 mo 1350 sp
they endy 1 ship in sight

Saturday 25th
Forepart Light Breeze & pleasant Middle
& Letter part the same they endy

Sunday 26th
Forepart Light & pleasant Breeze Middle
& Letter part the same they endy

Monday 27th
Light Breeze & pleasant all these
24 hours

Tuesday 28th
All then 24 hours Light Breeze & foggy

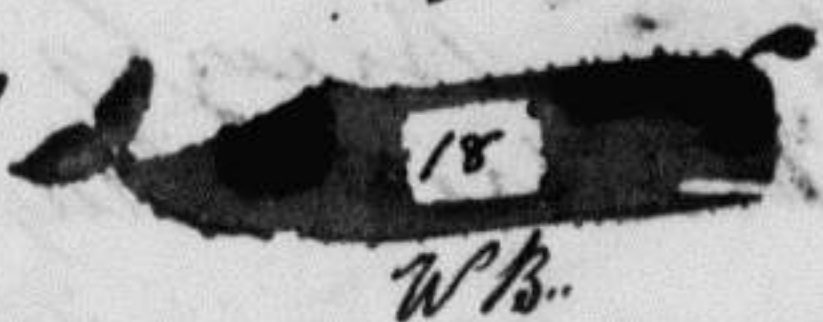
Wednesday 29th

Commenced with strong Breeze & play
at 4 P M Abington Bearing E by N Dist
12 miles saw a school of
Whale  Lowered all 3 boats
and got 1 to W R.
at dark took him to the ship at
day light commenced cutting at 8
finished they endy
