all 3 boats  L.B. struck 800 lbs W.B.
but lost him the bark, boat
struck one 100 lbs whale but don't know
whether they got it or not they ended

Thursday 7th

Forepart Light breezy & overcast Middle
& latter the same they ended

Friday 8th

Forepart Light breezy heading for North
head Middle & latter part the same

Saturday 9th

Commenced with strong breezes from
the S.E. head on opposite last
they ended they ended

Sunday 10th

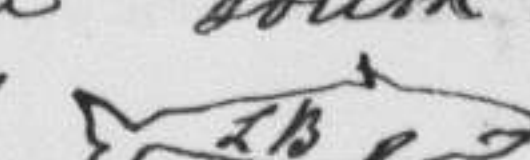
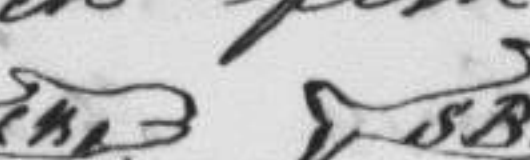
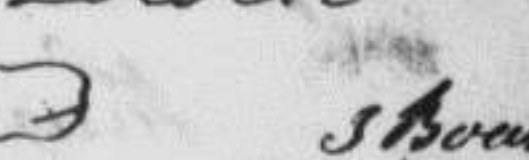
Forepart strong breezy saw 2

for 11 days seen nothing North West

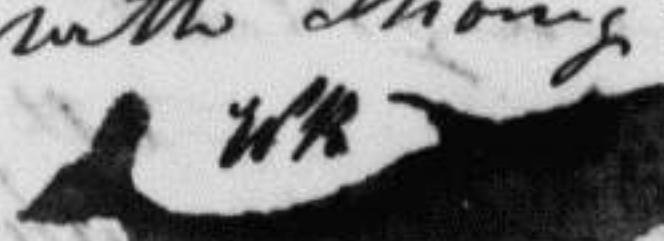
Saturday Dec 23rd 1848

on for the coast they ended

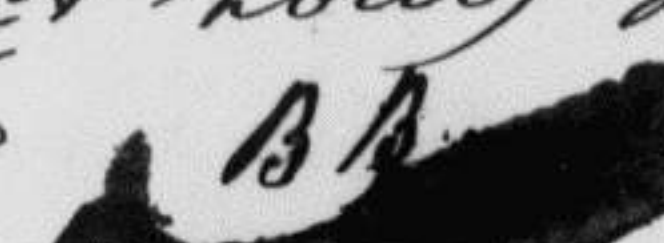
Tuesday Dec 27th

Lat 2 18 South Long 80 46 they ended

Commenced with strong breezes from the South
at 10 am   fish
saw black   they ended
& got 1 they ended
there 24 hours with nothing more
Land in sight

Thursday 29th

All those 24 hours strong breezy
from the   South
saw & got   they
black fish
ended these 24 hours
