Sunday 1st July 1849

Forepart Light pleasant Weather from the NW
Steering E N E Middle & Latter part the same
with fog squally
Lat 22 38 Long 87 18

Monday 2d 1849

Forepart Light Breezes from the N W Steering N E
by E all sail out Middle & Latter part the same
Lat 21 50 Long 85 23

Tuesday 3d 1849

Forepart Strong Breezes from the South wave Steering
N E by E all sail out Middle & Latter part the same
Lat 20 08 W Long 83 12

Wednesday 4th 1849

Commenced with strong Breezes from the E S E Long
N E most hulk Middle & Latter part the same
Lat 18 33 Long 81 42

Thursday 5th 1849

Forepart commenced with strong gale from
the E by S head N E by W under close reef
Top sail & fore sail saw a sail steering
W they ended
Lat 17 13 Long 80 39

Callao Bearing N 35 E Dist 36 2

Friday 6th 1849

Forepart Strong Breezes & pleasant Middle
Latter part the same Wind E S E Steering N E
Callao Bearing N 24 E Dist 23 6 miles
Lat 15 25 Long 78 50

Saturday 7th 1849

Forepart light Breezes from the E S E Steering N E
all sail out Middle part overcast Latter part
the same
Lat 14 05 Long 77 58
Callao Dist 12 4 miles N 25 E

Sunday 8th 1849

Forepart light Breezes & overcast saw Black Lower
& got away the Black fish
in steering
Latter part overcast this end there 24 hours
Lat 13 15 35 Long 77 26

Callao Dist 86 miles Bearing N 35 E

Monday 9th 1849

Forepart light Breezes from the S E heading N E
all sail out Middle part overcast Latter part the
same at Day Light made the Land Breeze
from N to N E & Dist 6 Leagues saw a Bark
working to the Windward they ended steering
N N W all sail out Employed Boiling
Black fish
Lat 12 58 South Long 76 15

Tuesday 10th 1849

Forepart light Breezes and foggy steering
N W by N all sail out saw a Brig bearing
N Latter part running down the Land
they ended 1 sail in sight Latter part
come to anchor at St. Lorenzo 7 miles
Dist from Town
