

Bark Junius Bound to Tahiti

Tuesday 30th

Forepart Light breeze from the S.W. Steering
N.E. all sail out. Middle part steering N.E. N
Letter part the same. Saw the Land on Bearing
by Sight 25 miles. Heavy Breeze

Lat 37.21 Long 73.50
Wednesday 31st 1848

Forepart Heavy Breeze from the South
Steering N.E. N all sail out. Middle part
Took in sail at 1 P.M. made sail steering
for Whenceana Middle and part the
same

Thursday 1st Nov

Forepart Heavy Breeze working up to the
port beam to anchor at 4 P.M. 68.37
5.27.3

Tahiti Nov 2nd 1848

I am undecided whether to go California or
not. 14th I have got my Discharge this Day
and got paid off 113 dollars. 16th I
was taken with the Desentary Last night
to Day have been to the Doctor and
he has given me some medicine with
he charged the Moderate price of 4.50
20th have not been out Doors for 3 days
and am very bad have had a Doctor every
Day and yesterday and today 21 25th
I am no better god know whether I shall
Die or Live 28 to Day Capt Russell come
in to see me and gave me a receipt
for the sickness have been out Doors to Day
I paid my Doctor Bill 37.50 cents
having been sick 14 days paid my bill
up to today at this Hotel for room
bed and attendance 18 dollars

Dec 2nd Day go on board the C Colon
Capt Coffin for California to sail to
Monroe

3rd got under way and went to sea bound
to Valparaiso 5th Arrived At Valparaiso
Went on shore saw James Baker he told
me my wife was well and child to
Vow I want to go home 9th Went on shore
to look for a chance to go home found
4 or 5 Capt Leach of the Chile of Boston
Offered me 80 dollars per month I shall
let him know to-morrow I can get more
but not to come home so quick I shall
tell him in the morning I shall go
10th Ship in the Chile Mate Bound
to Boston at 80 Dollars per month
11th went on board commenced Duty
12th got under way went down to Huasco
Arrived there 15 took in ~~16000~~ ¹⁶¹⁰⁰ weight of
Copper Ore 21st got under way and
Went down to Lardosa took in 34000
wt Copper Ore 30th got under way
and are bound to Akelah to take
in 250 tons of Salt peter
